Don't Believe the Hype

Important Information about W-2s, Taxes, and Health Reform

LIE: Beginning next year, employers will report health care benefits as income on W-2 forms and workers will have to pay taxes on these benefits.

THE TRUTH: Employers are required to start reporting the dollar value of an employee's health care benefits on W-2 forms in 2011 in anticipation of when a proposed excise tax may apply in 2018. **But NO ONE will be taxed on their benefits. After 2018, health plans may be taxed on just the part of a participant's benefits that rise above a certain level.**

As with most of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care law, there is a lot that still needs to be clarified by regulatory agencies.

Any employer or citizen that's claiming that benefits will be taxed prior to 2018 is flat-out lying and misrepresenting the law.
