President Obama announced on Friday that he would stand up for U.S. workers and impose tariffs on Chinese tire imports. This decision was a response to the trade case that our union brought over surges in tire imports that have resulted in thousands of lost jobs in our country.

This move by our President signals a sharp turn from his predecessor, who refused to provide relief in four other similar trade cases with China. The industries in these cases are being decimated. President Obama's decision in the current case will give our tire workers a fighting chance.

This is a huge victory for U.S. workers, trade law enforcement, and our union.

The credit for this win is shared by every one of you who wrote a letter to the President supporting this case. More than 80,000 letters from USW activists went into the White House in just over four weeks! These letters came from all industry sectors and all parts of the country and is a show of the strength we have when we act collectively.
